

Sabina Pendse serves as a Sustainable Communities Coordinator for the US Environmental Protection Agency's Regional Office in New York City. Sabina works in the Clean Air and Sustainability Division of Region 2 (which covers New Jersey, New York, Puerto Rico, the U.S. Virgin Islands and eight federally recognized Indian Nations) on cross-media programs. Through her work she collaborates with other federal agencies, state and local governments, and community-based groups to provide assistance and support for the development of policies, programs, and guidelines that help communities become more sustainable through smart growth and green building. Sabina represents EPA Region 2 on the HUD DOT EPA Partnership for Sustainable Communities, participating in the regional interagency effort to help improve access to affordable housing, provide more transportation options, and lower transportation costs while protecting the environment in communities nationwide, and is also the lead for many other EPA sustainable communities initiatives in New York and New Jersey.

Sabina joined EPA as a Presidential Management Fellow in Region 2's Office of Policy and Management in 2010. She has also served as the Region 2 Sustainable Schools Coordinator, working with K-12 schools to facilitate the implementation of sustainability actions. She completed a stint in EPA HQ's Office of Sustainable Communities where she continued to refine her expertise in EPA's work in the fields of smart growth and economic development. Prior to joining EPA, Sabina served as an advisor to several Permanent Missions to the United Nations on sustainable development and climate change issues.

Sabina received a Master of Environmental Management from Yale University, with a focus on Water Science, Policy and Economics. While at Yale, she conducted research at the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization in Rome, Italy, exploring economic valuation of multiple use water systems. Sabina earned a BA in Philosophy, Politics and Economics (PPE) and Environmental Studies from the University of Pennsylvania, where she graduated with honors. Sabina is also a LEED Green Associate, and has a professional Certification for Teaching English as a Foreign Language (TEFL).
